**Is this a light?** *No, it isn't a light. It's a wall.*  
**Is this a sofa?** *No, it isn't a sofa. It's a chair.*

<b>Is my book closed?</b>	<i>No, your book isn't closed. It's open.</i>
<b>high</b> [haɪ] <b>low</b> [ləʊ] <b>the Eiffel tower</b> [aɪfl 'taʊə] <b>a supermarket</b> [ə 'su:pəmə:kɪt]	
<i>A supermarket is low. The Eiffel tower is high.</i>	
<b>Is the ceiling high in the living room?</b>	<i>Yes, the ceiling's high in the living room.</i>
<b>Is a supermarket low?</b>	<i>Yes, a supermarket is low.</i>
<b>Is the Eiffel tower high?</b>	<i>Yes, the Eiffel tower is high.</i>
<b>Is a supermarket high?</b>	<i>No, a supermarket isn't high. It's low.</i>
<b>Is the Eiffel tower low?</b>	<i>No, the Eiffel tower isn't low. It's high.</i>
<b>or</b> [ɔ:]	
<b>Am I a man or a woman?</b>	<i>You are a woman.</i>
<b>Are you a student or a teacher?</b>	<i>I am a student.</i>
<b>Is she a boy or a girl?</b>	<i>She is a girl.</i>
<b>Is the man tall or short?</b>	<i>The man is tall.</i>
<b>Is the key large or small?</b>	<i>The key is small.</i>
<b>Is this a door or a window?</b>	<i>It's a window.</i>
<b>Is this a table or a chair?</b>	<i>It's a chair.</i>

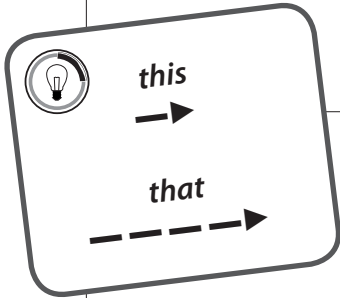
